
EXHIBITION OPENS TO CELEBRATE THE HUMAN BODY

A POWERFUL and evocative exhibition celebrating the human body as an art form opened at the weekend.

Diverse work from locally and nationallyrenowned artists is on display at the Henshaws Arts and Crafts Centre, in Knaresborough, North Yorkshire.

Body Art includes textile costumes by Anna Cocciadiferro, which visitors can try on, and large paintings featuring close-ups of human faces by London artist Danielle Eubank.

The centre's resident artists have also contributed to the show, with wood sculptures by Simon Haw, jewellery by Debra Roberts and bottle-top necklaces by Ken Prow all available for viewing.

The exhibition runs until June 2 and the centre is open seven days a week, from 10am to 5pm.
